## 2008-2009 DRESS CODE POLICY

Students are expected to be in their proper school uniform every day. Clothes should always look clean and well kept (ironed, with replaced buttons and fixed hems as necessary). Students are required to keep shirts buttoned and tucked in. If a student is not dressed appropriately in uniform, the student will receive a uniform violation. After three uniform violations, the student will be required to serve lunch detention. Persistent uniform violations will be deemed non-compliance with the Code of Conduct and a parent conference with the administrator will be scheduled.

### **Hairstyles**

Boys' hair length should not extend below the collar. Fad/unconventional hairstyles are not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to, hair dye and unconventional cuts or styling as determined by the administration. All students are expected to keep their hair clean, well kept, and out of their eyes.

### **Cosmetics**

Middle school girls are permitted to use moderate applications of make-up. The administration reserves the right to define "moderate" when questions arise. 5<sup>th</sup> grade girls are not permitted to wear make-up.

### **Nail Polish**

Girls are allowed to wear light pink, pearl, beige, or clear nail polish. A student who comes to school with another color will be required to remove it.

### **Jewelry/Decorative Items**

Jewelry and other decorative items (e.g., brightly colored scarves and headbands) are not part of the BCA uniform. Girls may wear only one single small stud earring in each ear and a single small ring. Boys may not wear earrings or other jewelry.

### **Undershirts**

When an undershirt is necessary, a plain white shirt must be worn. T-shirts with any emblem, decal, or artwork are not permitted. Undershirts should fit so as not to extend beyond the outer shirt.

### **Dress for Extended Care**

Students who remain at school for afternoon Extended Care are to remain in their school uniform unless participating in a BCA-sponsored activity that requires other attire (e.g., BCA sports, Tae Kwon Do, dance instruction).

### **Identification of Clothing**

Since the students wear uniforms, it is necessary that all items of clothing be marked with the student's name. BCA cannot be held responsible for the loss of a student's clothing.

### **NUT Day ("No Uniform Today" Day)**

Middle school students have the opportunity to earn one day each quarter on which they are not required to wear their school uniform. A student who maintains an excellent appearance in uniform for the entire quarter (no violations in what is worn or in neatness of appearance) will be given a pass to participate in the designated NUT Day. The student will receive a copy of the NUT Day dress code with his/her first NUT Day pass. If a student violates the NUT Day dress code, he/she will be disqualified from all future NUT Days for the school year.

### **CAMPUS 2 UNIFORM OPTIONS**

**\*These items MUST be purchased from the Flynn & O'Hara Uniform Company.**

**Girls' Options (Option components are not interchangeable.)**

#### **Option #1 for Middle School Girls Only**

- White oxford blouse (short or long sleeves)
- \*Plaid uniform skirt (**Skirts must be no shorter than mid-knee.**)
- \*Maroon knee socks or maroon ribbed tights
- Black shoes with heels not to exceed one inch

#### **Option #1 for 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Girls Only**

- Peter Pan blouse (short or long sleeves)
- \*Plaid jumper (Jumpers must be no shorter than mid-knee.)
- \*Maroon knee socks or maroon ribbed tights
- Black shoes with heel not to exceed one inch

**Option #2 for Girls**

- \*White, cardinal, or navy blue golf shirt (short or long sleeves) with BCA logo
- \*Navy blue or khaki uniform pants
- Plain black belt (no rivets, cutouts, or other decoration)
- Navy blue or beige socks to match pants
- Black shoes with heels not to exceed one inch

**Boys' Uniform**

- \*White, cardinal, or navy blue golf shirt (short or long sleeves) with BCA logo
- \*Navy blue or khaki uniform pants
- Plain black belt
- Navy blue or beige socks to match pants
- Black shoes

**P.E. Uniform**

- \*White or gray logo gym shirt (Gray with torch logo gym shirt will be phased out by the 2009-2010 school year.)
- \*Navy blue logo gym shorts (Blue with torch logo gym shorts will be phased out by the 2009-2010 school year.)
- \*Navy blue logo sweatpants & \*sweatshirt (Sweatpants to be worn over the shorts during the school day. Wearing a sweatshirt is optional.)
- White crew socks
- Sneakers with non-marking soles

**Field Trip Attire** (Each student must have a field trip uniform.)

- \*Cardinal golf shirt (short or long sleeves) with BCA logo
- \*Navy blue uniform pants
- Plain black belt
- Navy blue socks
- Black shoes

**Sports Uniforms**

The sports fees cover the cost of team uniforms for BCA competitive sports teams. In addition, boys are required to wear a dress shirt and tie to school on game days.

**Colder Weather**

The \*cardinal cardigan, the \*BCA logo fleece jacket, or a BCA Christmas program sweatshirt are options for colder months. Christmas sweatshirts should only be worn with the pants option. Non-uniform sweaters and jackets are not permitted in the classrooms.

**Clothing Items Not Permitted**

- Shorts
- Corduroy pants
- Boots
- Long-sleeved shirts under short-sleeved uniform shirts
